Smoker lighting overview, protective gear inspection, and guided walkthrough of the hive yard.

1130 - 1230

Lunch On-Site

A casual break with provided lunch, beverages, and a chance to connect with others.

1230 - 1300

Smoker Lighting Practice

Hands-on demonstration and individual practice prior to live inspections.

1300 - 1600

Field Activities – Hive Work & Observation

Participants will take part in various beekeeping tasks suited to the season and hive needs.

1600 - 1700

Wrap-Up & Discussion

Final classroom session, Q&A, and review of key takeaways.
